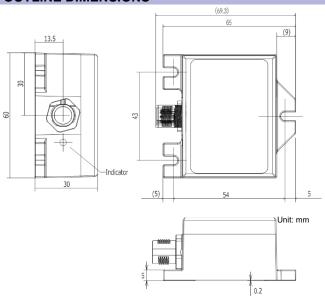
Sensor

- *4. Selectable by register setting.

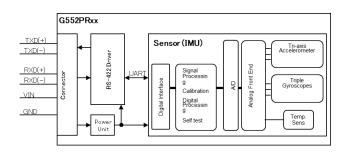

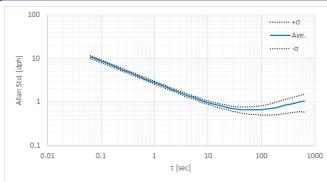

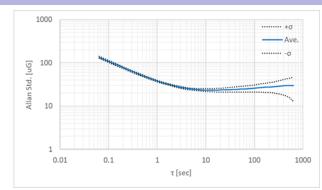


BLOCK DIAGRAM
